Children - to the Home
Government - & I am sure
you will do so - but privately
I may tell you - I never
again intend to take any
more workhouse children

The children from the one
house - were covered with
any room - & the children
from the other were covered
with itch! - they infected
30 of my dear children, &
it kept a trained nurse for
over six weeks - sulphurating
& bathing them - to get them
into anything like a condition
- so as far as I am
concerned - I shall enquire
myself ^{for the future} to the children of
my own Lord's house
home - I am respecting
